### **About Our Site**

Braswell Farm is a working farm that uses their fields for raising cattle. Fields are a combination of woods and open although some are surrounded by barbed wire fences and include groundcover native to the area that occasionally is mowed.

### **Notes to Exhibitors**

Chapter 3, Section 1, of the Tracking Regulations: “Eligibility. This test will be for dogs not less than six (6) months of age that are eligible for entry and that meet the requirements of the following Section 2.

A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the titles TD, TDX or VST. Dogs not holding a Tracking Dog title will be given priority for entry in the test by the tracking test secretary.”

**Bitches in season** may participate in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8, of the Tracking Regulations.

### **Notes to Exhibitors and Spectators**

- The Test Secretary’s cell phone is available the day of the test for emergency contact: (404) 488-9673
- Tracking test hours: 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.
- Park only in designated areas.
- Pick up after yourselves and your dogs.
- Bring your own shade, chairs, and water.
- Dogs are not allowed off lead during test hours.
- Any complaints from motels regarding exhibitors may result in a bench show committee hearing.
- All persons on the property used for the test must sign a waiver of liability. This form will be available at the draw.
- No smoking on the testing grounds.
- Chapter 1, Section 17 of the Tracking Regulations: “**Dogs Running Free.** Due to the changing nature of the fields being used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public, dogs must be “on lead” at all times on any area of the tracking site.”

**Directions to Draw Site (Crosstrack Farm)**  
110 Fitzpatrick Road, Athens, Georgia 30607-2308

From I-85 take Hwy 441 south (exit 149) towards Athens for about 15 miles to the intersection of 441 and hwy 334 on the left and old 441 to the right. Turn right at this light. There will be a Chevron station on the southwest corner. Follow old 441 for about 0.1 miles to the railroad tracks. Fitzpatrick Road will be on your left between the tracks and the warning gate for the south bound traffic. Look for the tracking flags marking the drive. Follow the dirt road until it forks (100 yards). Turn right and HQ will be in the building on your left.

From Athens, take 441 North (exit 12) towards Commerce for about 13 miles until you reach the intersection of 441 and hwy 334 to the right and old 441 to the left. Turn left and follow the directions above.

**Directions to Test Site (Braswell Farm) From Crosstrack Farm**

Follow the drive to 441. Turn left go 0.2 miles to Kings Bridge Road and turn left. Go another .1 miles to Chandler Bridge Road and turn left. The tracking fields will be about 2.5 miles on the left. Look for the tracking flags that mark the gate where you will turn left.

I (WE) ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THE Rules Applying to Dog Shows and, if this entry is for an obedience trial, the Obedience Regulations, have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC-approved judge, judging at this show, under AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

[1] (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

[2] The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

[3] (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

[4] A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
